Aaron spoke with great passion regarding the need for an updated Skate Park for Howick.

Aaron spoke about the need for a Skate Park to be available for Inline Skaters, Skateboarding, BMX and Scootering. The facility must be suitable for beginners and advanced skaters with sufficient space for all enjoy.

The provision of a new Skate Park will be expensive and has to follow a lengthy process. Short term Aaron advocates the existing facility to be improved so that it can be used safely.

The current Skatepark at Lloyd Elsmore has very rough concrete and causes severe injuries when skaters bail. Also there is a lack of facilities such as Water Fountains, Parking and Waste Bins.


